#### CHARLES HERBERT (BERT) GARDINER

## Passionate in his support of athletic

Athlete, Australian athletics selector and manager.  
Born: December 26, 1901.  
Died: June 26, 1994.

WHEN Herb Elliott smashed the world mile record at the 1958 British Empire Games few people were as excited as Bert Gardiner.

As manager of the Australian team and passionate supporter of athletics it was one of the highlights of his life.

Gardiner was a brilliant athlete who was stopped from fulfilling his Olympic dream by a lack of money and World War II.

He held the Australian record for the seven-mile walk and was the oldest person to have completed

a marathon until his recent death.

His son, triple Olympian walker Bob Gardiner, said his father was a meticulous selector who was committed to choosing the best athletes.

Bob said his father was ideally suited to working with athletes because of his sense of humor and integrity.

"He never bore a grudge and always saw good in people," he said.

Bert Gardiner was a spritely man who never owned a car and in 1987 he competed in the World Veterans Athletics Championship in Melbourne in over-85s division — winning silver.

He is survived by son Bob and daughter Joan.
