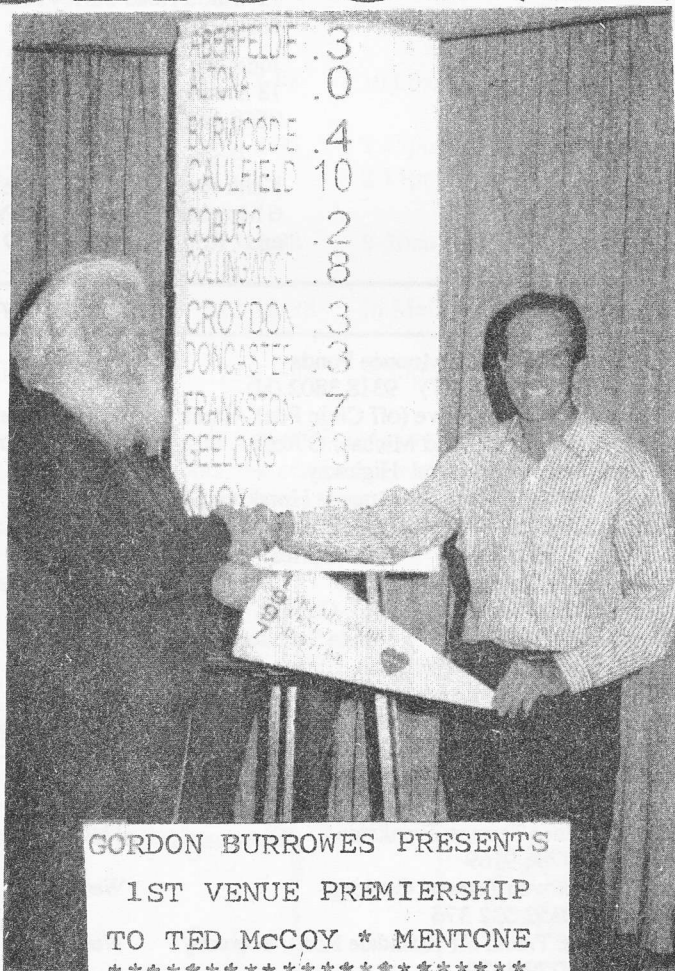

AQUATHON - RUN/SWIM OR WALK/SWIM

DATE: Sunday 8th February 1998 at 8.30 am.

PLACE: Lilydale Lake, Swansea Rd, Lilydale (Melways 38F6). Swansea Rd is the continuation of Canterbury Rd. It takes 20 minutes to drive from the corner of Canterbury Rd & Springvale Rd, Nunawading to Lilydale Lake.

COST: \$7.00 for both Run/Swim and Walk/Swim. Entry is on the day.

TROPHIES: To first placegetters in all age groups, male and female, runners and walkers.

FINISH CERTIFICATES: Will be provided to all entrants. These will supply both the run (or walk) time, plus the finish time.

RUN DISTANCE: 5K on a flat, clay/gravel walking path around the lake. You will encounter no cars, or unleashed dogs. Only two very slight inclines in 5K. No crowding - the walking path can accommodate three runners, running side by side.

WALK DISTANCE: 2.5K on the same walking path as above.

SWIM DISTANCE: 400 metres (measured) for both runners and walkers. The first leg is 285 metres. Then a 5 metre run around two flags on a beach. Then 115 metres to the finish.

SWIM SAFETY: For most of the swim you can stand up in the water. The 5 metre run around the flags on the beach allows you a breather (and a rest if you want it). You can stand up in the water for the entire last 115 metres, when you might be tired.

Life guards will be on two surf boards plus one canoe. Two other life guards will be treading water along the swim leg, and two further life guards will be stationed on two jetties at the 100 and 200 metre marks of the swim leg.

WATER QUALITY: The Lilydale Lake is used for triathlons, and the water quality is satisfactory. Water is continually arriving at the lake naturally from nearby hills, and leaving via a spillway. The water looks like normal dam water.

ALLOWABLE FLOTATION DEVICES: You can wear a life jacket, a full wet suit, or any other flotation device. However, flippers, hand paddles and wet suit tops are not allowed. (There is no competitive advantage in wearing a full wet suit, because by the time you get it on, your competitors will be 100 metres away. However, there is a competitive advantage in wearing a wet suit top, therefore these are not allowed).

AFTER THE RACE: A sausage sizzle, plus sandwiches, tea, coffee and biscuits will all be provided free to entrants and friends. Shelter is available should it be raining.

WHEN WILL I GET HOME TO MY BELOVED: The last finisher should be in by 10.00 am. Presentation of trophies and Finishing Certificates, plus socialising, should be over by 11.00 am. You should be home before 12 noon.

This Aquathon is conducted by the East Burwood Vets as a service to all Veteran athletes. This is not a fund raising venture, and the \$7.00 entry fee has been set so that it (just) covers the cost of hiring the lake facilities, plus trophies and Finishing Certificates.

1998 OCEANIA VETERAN GAMES

The 9th OCEANIA VETERAN GAMES have been allocated to New Zealand and will be held in HAWKES BAY over the period 17-25 January 1998.

HAWKES BAY is on the east coast of the North Island of New Zealand and is easily accessible from Auckland, Wellington or Christchurch by plane, bus, train or by rental car. The Hawkes Bay region is noted for its agriculture and horticulture. Fruit is grown in abundance - so much so that the region is known as the "fruit bowl of New Zealand" and is equally famous for its wine. The infrastructure includes two cities (Napier and Hastings) each with populations of 55,000 and they are only 14km apart.

The "BAY" as a region is rich in history, culture and scenic attractions. The weather is often claimed to be the best in the country. Certainly the area is noted for its long, hot and dry summers.

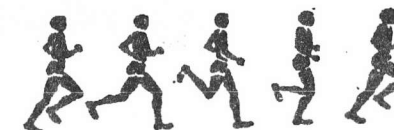
The Games will feature a full track and field programme (including multi events) for men and women. In addition there will be a half marathon, cross country events and 10km road walks. All of this activity will be spread over a seven day period which will include at least one layday. All events will be split into the traditional five year age groups starting at age 40 for men and 35 for women. There will be events for preveterans who are defined as men aged 35-39 and women 30-34. There will be no qualifying standards. Entry forms will be available in May 1997.

The Games are primarily the regional championships for veteran athletes of the relevant Veteran Associations affiliated to the Oceania Association of Veteran Athletes (OAVA). These athletes have automatic right of entry. However veteran athletes from member countries of any of the other WAVA Regions around the world are welcome to compete but of course are not eligible to claim Oceania titles.
