Olympic Torch A Unifier

Articles From Herald Sun - By Shaun Phillips

THE Olympic flame was already in Tokyo by the time Christine Griffiths walked into St Carthage's in Parkville yesterday morning.

Worshippers could have been forgiven, however, for thinking Melbourne's torch relay had entered a second day. Ms Griffiths went to church in her official tracksuit, torch in hand.

"I wanted to thank God that I had achieved something in my life that I had never dreamed about," she said.

"It was an amazing experience to be part of such a unifying event."

Ms Griffiths, 55, was selected for the Athens relay in recognition of her work with the Bone Marrow Donor Institute.

Relay runners were able to buy their Olympic torches for \$500. Ms Griffiths' sponsor paid for hers.

Nick Walsh, 29, said he was offered \$1000 for his torch.

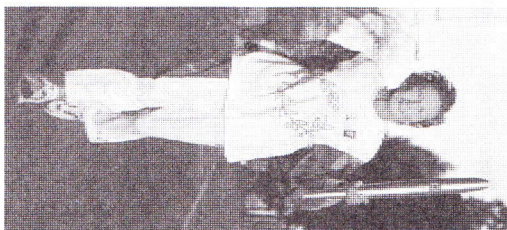
"I won't be selling it, it's priceless," he said.

Victorian Olympic Council president Jim Barry said Athens chiefs had told him Melbourne had set the benchmark for the 31 remaining cities in the international torch relay.

"It was a huge exercise involving hundreds of people across many agencies," he said.

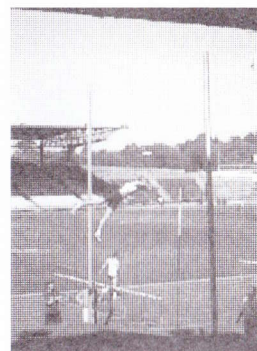
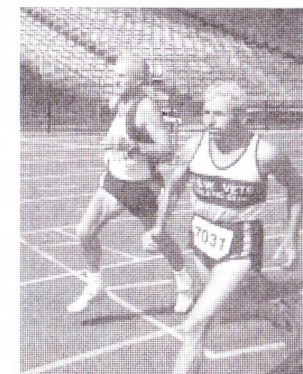
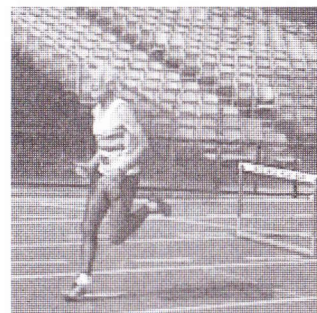

MINUTES:

The minutes of the previous Annual General Meeting held on Monday 5th May 2003 were read by the vice president and were accepted as a true and correct record on the motion of Graeme Murfett and Colin Browne.

PRESENTATION OF ANNUAL REPORTS:

Written reports had been submitted by office bearers and venue managers which were distributed at the meeting. Graeme Rose expressed disappointment that the reports from the president, club captain and a few venues were not ready for inclusion in the report and that many copies of the report had some pages printed upside down.

Tony Bradford and John Dean gave a verbal report of activities at Aberfeldie venue.

Dot Browne gave praise to the managers of Croydon venue.

Graeme Rose praised the efforts of throwers in organising and conducting events.

Secretary's Report, as attached. Accepted on motion of A. Lucas and A. Wood

Treasurers Report. As attached. Accepted by motion of D. McLean and B. Courtenay
Don McLean explained to the meeting how the new AV discount policy works.

Colin Browne spoke in praise of treasurer Don McLean for the work that he had done for the club over recent years.

The auditors Peter Le Get and Keith Routley had found the books and accounts of the club to be in accordance with the report.

Members were advised that a supply of medals with the old VVACI emblem on them were being held. Leo Charles offered to buy some at a discounted price. The chairman referred to the matter to the incoming committee for a decision.

OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARDS

Rob Waters presented plaques for outstanding service to Graeme Paul and Wasy! Drosdowsky of Collingwood venue, Kevin McGrath of Caulfield venue and Richard Trembath of Doncaster venue for their work as venue managers. In addition a special service award was given to Don McLean for his work as treasurer and also for the additional work that he had done in relation to the recent AMA National championships in Melbourne.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSES

The public officer made the appropriate statement of purposes of the club in accordance with section 30 (3) of the Act. The motion to receive the statement of purposes was carried.

GENERAL BUSINESS

It was reported that Royce Foley was very unwell and that members John Brown and Barbara Dalgleish had recently passed away.

Tony Bradford suggested that the club recommend to AMA to change the program at the Nationals so that the 400m not be held on the final day.

Alan Lucas advised that after working on medal presentations at the Nationals that it would not be feasible to hold formal presentations for events at the Victorian Championships due to time and manpower requirements.

Colin Browne spoke in favour of holding the Victorian championships at Olympic Park because of the better facilities for competitors and spectators. Graeme Rose raised concern about the lack of toilet facilities at Yarra Park and the poor PA system.

A general discussion was held regarding the programming of events for the ensuing winter season. Club Captain David Sheehan advised the meeting that the program is set on a yearly basis and can be changed each year and feedback should be forwarded to him.

Alan Lucas advised that venue managers meetings will now be held twice yearly and that the next one in August would concentrate on publicity and promotion.

Ian U'Ren spoke re the Knox Healthy Ageing Expo and the need for the club to update it's promotional material.

A final meeting of the Nationals Organising Committee will be held on Monday 24 May.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Competition Rules: The competition will be conducted under IAAF/WMA/OAVA rules subject to any special rules included herein or laid down by the Organizing Committee. Entry signifies that each competitor will abide by the rules laid down by the Organizing and Technical Committees.

Age Groups

Competition will be conducted in the following age groups:

Men

M 30-34, M35-39, M40-44, M45-49, M50-54, M55-59, M60-64, M65-69, M70-74, M75-79, M80-84, M85-89, M90-94, M95 and over.

Women

W30-34, W35-39, W40-44, W45-49, W50-54, W55-59, W60-64, W65-69, W70-74, W75-79, W80-84, W85-89, W90-94, W95 and over.

Combined Events: where there are insufficient entries to justify separate races being held for any Age Group(s), events will be run as combined events at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and the Meeting Manager. Separate awards will of course be made for each age group

Age Group Qualification: In accordance with WMA Rules, competitors may only compete in the age Group for which they qualify on the first day of the Games, 21 st October 2004, and in no other Age Group. Proof of age is required with entry (Copy of birth certificate or Passport)

Multiple Events Order:

Weight Pentathlon: Hammer, Shot, Discus, Javelin, Weight Men's Pentathlon: Long Jump, Javelin, 200m, Discus, 1500m Women's Pentathlon: 100m, Shot, Long Jump, Javelin, 800m

Implements

Implements for field events will be provided by the Organizing Committee, however competitors may place their own implements in the pool for competition, provided the Equipment Official has certified the implements at least 90 minutes before the event. Such implements must be available for use by all competitors. Exclusive use by the owner is not permitted.

Starting Blocks will be available. Athletes who wish to use their own may do so.

Finals will be run at advertised final times

Team Events

Team events (3 per team) will be conducted in the Road Races, Road Walks and Cross Country events in age groups. In order to assist competition and provide opportunities for the maximum number of athletes to be part of the team competition, the age groups for the team competition will be decided by the Organizing Committee after the closing date for entries.

Teams will be determined on a national basis and do not need to be declared before the start. Team Placings will be determined by totalling the times of each teams first three finishers. Only one team per country.

Relays

Relays will be conducted on a national basis in the following age bands:

Women 150 to 189 years, 190years and over

Men 150 to 179 years, 180 to 209 years & 210 years & over.

Relays will be conducted over the following distances for both men and women: 4 x 100m and Medley (2 x 200m, 1 x 400m and 1 x 800m).

Relay entries will be taken on the day before each event (i.e. Tuesday 26 th October 2004)

Awards

Medals will be presented to the first, second and third place getters from the Oceania Region.

Medals will also be presented to entrants from outside the Oceania Region finishing in the first three places in any events.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Closing Date for Entries: 31 August 2004.

Entries received from 1st September to 30th September will ONLY be accepted with the payment of a \$50.00 late fee.

Late Entries will NOT be accepted after 30th September 2004

Entries: should be sent to Oceania Veteran Athletics Championships 2004, P O Box 569, Rarotonga, COOK ISLANDS. All Entries received will be acknowledged in writing not later than 1 October 2004.

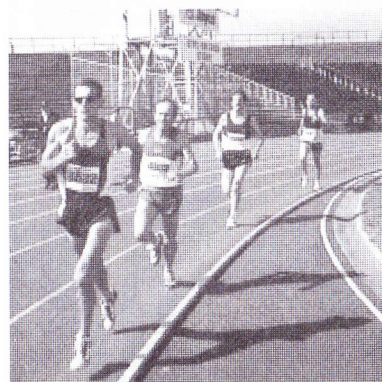
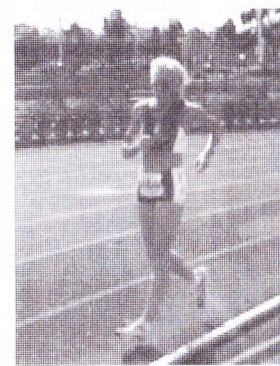
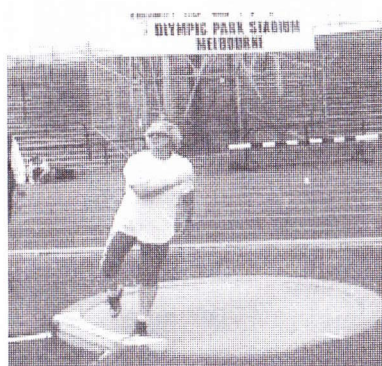

Umpire Mourned

UMPIRES and junior players in the Dandenong and District Junior Football League wore black armbands in round one as a mark of respect to popular umpire Donald Corrie, 54, who died in Monash Medical Centre on April 3.



Widely known as Don, Mr Corrie of Noble Park suffered a heart attack while at the Veterans' Athletics Club in Ross Reserve, Noble Park, on March 26.

He was a life member of the Dandenong Umpires Association and of the DDJFL where he spent many years umpiring.

His son Glenn said his family and sport were the most important things in his father's life.

"Dad was associated most with junior football. Our whole family except mum — myself, Greg and Kristy — all umpired junior matches.

"Mum is still involved assisting at social functions. She runs the canteen at Greaves Reserve in Bennet Street, Dandenong.

"His family and his sport were dad's life. He was a member of the Victorian Veterans' Athletics (Springvale Branch), was a runner and was very fit.

"He took up bike riding and would ride up to 100 kilometres on a Saturday. He often rode in the evenings after work."

He said his father barracked for Melbourne in the AFL and loved watching football when he wasn't umpiring.

Mr Corrie was born in Carnegie and his mother, Patricia, still lives in Oakleigh.

He attended local primary and secondary schools and started his working career as an electrical apprentice with the Victorian Railways.

He was senior maintenance coordinator at the Epping train maintenance depot with Alstom which maintains Connex trains.

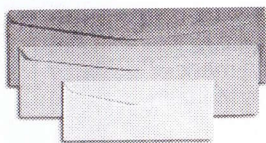
He had many postings and jobs over more than 30 years on the railways, including relocating to Mildura from 1976 to 1980 as the depot foreman there.

He was six months away from retirement when he had the heart attack.

In a tribute his workmates said: "We will miss Don's subtle humour and the reassuring words of encouragement, the many happy times we have shared, the visits to the MCG but, most of all, we will miss you."

More than 400 mourners paid tribute to Mr Corrie at a funeral service on April 7 in the Boyd Chapel at the Springvale Necropolis.

THEY'RE breaking the sound barrier at a Kingston council owned reserve - and nearby residents have had a gut full.

Perhaps that should be 'ear full' because they are sick and tired of the noise constantly invading their privacy at all times of the day, night and weekends.

The noise comes from the public address system at Dolamure Oval, which is primarily used for athletics and school sports.

The excessive noise levels were listed among many complaints lodged by residents in a recent petition to council.

The residents want action on a veteran athletics organisation which chooses to use streets surrounding the reserve rather than the expensive professional athletics track for its training allegedly because it is easier to count the laps they do by running around the street.

Blocking street too

Residents want the veterans to stop blocking access to parts of their street with 'witches hats' and also to put a stop to the verbal

abuse allegedly used by the veteran athletes toward residents who complain about being unable to travel along their streets safely and properly.

Cr. Bill Nixon and, more recently, council officers have inspected the problem listed by residents.

The Independent understands two council officers visited Second St. Mentone during a school sports carnival at the reserve last week and totally agreed with activist Astrid Van Dyke that the noise levels were totally unacceptable both inside and outside her home.

It is also understood that a council engaged sound engineer visited the site that same afternoon and he is alleged to have told Ms. Van Dyke the noise levels were 60 per cent higher than those regarded as acceptable by the Environment Protection Authority.

The Department of Justice has written to residents advising them of a mediation meeting to be held soon.

No date has been mentioned.

Council will hold meetings with residents and also with the Dolamore oval management committee in an attempt to solve the ongoing disputes about the sound system and problems with the veteran athletics body.

Ward councillor Bill Nixon has already indicated his intention to attend all meetings.

NEW VICTORIAN, AUSTRALIAN & PENDING WORLD RECORDS

Important note for anyone even remotely likely to break a record.

It has been apparent of late that athletes need to be involved much more, and take greater responsibility for, claiming their performances as records. Over the years a number of athletes discovered all too late, and to their great disappointment, that bettering a record does not automatically mean their performance will ever be accepted. Certainly not by World Masters Athletics (WMA).

The first and smartest action of all is to alert officials before competition even starts that there is a chance of you breaking a record.

You should never assume officials will have 3 watches on you, or that they will have lap scorers, or that there are sufficient walk judges, or that someone is recording wind readings, or that someone will run around collecting signatures from the starter, timekeepers or photo finish judge, or field judges, or equipment officer, and then fill out a record application form for you. In fact, don't assume anyone will even have a record application form. If there is none available, please collect signatures and times on a sheet of paper, as soon as possible after the performance. Qualified officials will usually be able to provide a form of some kind, and assist in filling it out.

The WMA World Championship is the only competition where world record application forms are not required to be submitted. Mind you, WMA have still not accepted the W60 400m world record performance of 67.30s by Ann Stobaus in a W55 400m Final, from Brisbane in 2001, despite several claims. Irene Obera holds the current record of 67.80s from USA.

If you are not sure about any of this, please contact me. I am also always pleased to hear of any record-breaking performance via a quick phone call (followed by a claim in writing). I have great difficulty obtaining results, particularly from Masters Games. My contact details are listed below, but they are always at the end of New Record reports. Note there have been recent changes to my address and phone numbers.

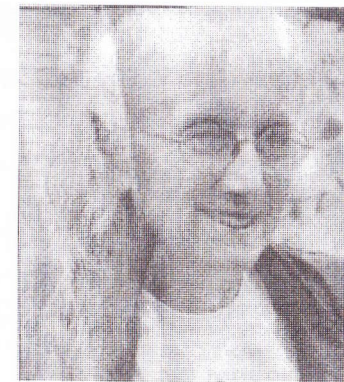
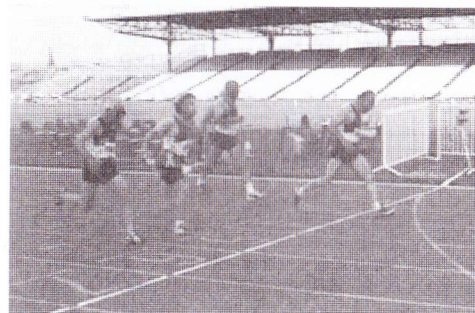
She now holds the Victorian record for the one mile event, Australian and Victorian records for the 1500 metre and the Australian record for the 20 kilometre.
