#### AMA Nationals Brisbane

Eleven of our members made the journey to Brisbane for this long-awaited National Championships. The first chance since the Melbourne 2019 event for masters athletes to compete for a National title. The event was held from 1st – 4th April, 2022 with medals dated 2020 – à la Tokyo 2020 ©

The results for all of our throwers are attached with the standout being from **Tom Hancock** who achieved a cleansweep of six gold medals in the throws (plus another for high jump)! Tom also broke the Australian Record in the Weight Throw and all of his throws performances were Victorian Records.

All this was to spite the fact that Tom was basically unable to train in the weeks leading up to the event. This was due to his training venue being under water after the devastating floods throughout northern NSW where Tom and his wife Margaret now reside. But Tom is a Victorian through and through so still competes for VMA at national championships.
